Dear Students, Parents and Guardians:

This is always such an exciting time of year for educators and this school year is no exception. In the past five years John Adams High School has seen an increase in nearly every academic category and a major decrease in the number of suspensions. During the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years, the students, faculty and parents helped JA earn a state accountability letter grade of A. This past school year John Adams High School ranked #44 in the State of Indiana, in the top 12% Nationally in the U.S. News Best High School rankings. John Adams High School is one of two High Schools in St. Joseph County to rank in Indiana's top 50. Our graduation rate has soared over 90% the past five years, while the number of students earning International Baccalaureate Diplomas and Certificates is at an all-time high. As our students excel in the classroom, our extra-curricular activities are also soaring. We hosted the 2019 Mock Trial Regional Competition sending eight teams to the state competition. The band, choir and orchestra won several state awards while our visual arts won many state and national awards. Finally, our athletic teams enjoyed great success in the classroom and in competition.

We pride ourselves at John Adams High School on maintaining the same level of excellence that was started in 1940. As we look forward to this school year, we will hold our students to high expectations and build positive relationships with them. Our ultimate goal is for each student who enters our building to graduate from John Adams High School as we prepare them for life after high school. We will prepare each graduate for success in college and/or careers so they can become productive members of society. We take great pride in our community at John Adams High School as we are all members of TEAM SOUTH BEND.

SBCSC HIGH SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

All student and staff expectations are put in place in order to ensure the safety of each student, faculty member and guest of John Adams High School. Behavior that comprises this safety will not be tolerated. It is the expectation that each student acts appropriately at all times. All school expectations apply the moment a student leaves their home until the moment they arrive home at the end of the day.

- *All students are expected to properly wear their **ID Cards** at all times while on the school campus. ID's will be issued during the first weeks of school. This ID is free. The cost of a replacement ID is \$5.00. The cost of a temporary 24 hour ID is \$1.00 and can only be worn on the day of purchase. ID's must be worn all day and are required for lunch.
- *Any student in the hall during class must have a pass from their period teacher.
- *Students are to move efficiently from one class to another and behave appropriately during passing periods.
- *Cell phones are **NOT** to be in use during instruction unless directed by a teacher. Violation will result in confiscation and/or additional consequences. Cooperation of students and parents is critical to eliminate the distraction of cell phones and other electronic devices at school.
- *Book bags and backpacks are not to be carried in the hallway, cafeteria or to class. They are to be kept in the students' locker during the school day.
- *Coats are not to be worn or carried during the school day. Coats must remain in lockers.
- *Students are to follow all classroom, Adams High School, and SBCSC rules and policies at all times.
- *Profanity and inappropriate, disrespectful, or abusive language are not permitted and will not be tolerated. Failure to comply will result in consequences.
- *If a parent needs to contact their student please call the Student Management Office, 393-5308, and a message will be delivered.

SBCSC ATTENDANCE POLICY

The School Board, as an agency of the State, is required to enforce regular attendance of students. The Board recognizes that the presence in the classroom enables the student to participate in instruction, class discussions, and other related activities. As such, regular attendance and classroom participation are integral to instilling incentives for the student to excel.

Attendance shall mean to be physically present in a school or at another location where the school's educational program is being conducted during regular school hours on a day in which the educational program in which the student is enrolled is being offered.

Attendance shall be required of all Corporation students, except those exempted under other provisions of State law, during the days and hours that the school is in session or during the attendance sessions to which s/he has been assigned.

The School Board policy requires a note from the parent of each student who has been absent for any reason. A written statement of the cause for such absence must be submitted within 48 hours of the absence to the Office of Student Management (Mrs. Hackett) to be considered excused. Administration reserves the right to verify such statements and to investigate the cause of each. This attendance policy holds the student responsible for his or her own absences. Students who choose not to bring in a note will be considered truant. Students must bring in a note for all absences and even though some may be considered unexcused those absences will not be considered truancies.

TARDIES

Students have five minutes for each passing period. In order to minimize classroom disruptions, we expect all students to arrive on time for class. Students who do not make it to class on time will be considered tardy. Chronic tardiness will be managed on an individual basis.

EXIT PASSES

All students are required to have an exit pass before leaving school. The nurse will issue exit passes for illnesses and the student management office will issue them for all other appointments. Please call the student management office at 393-5308 in advance to obtain an exit pass for appointments.

DRESS CODE

John Adams will not have required uniforms this year but will follow the SBCSC dress code. The following items, apparel or appearance are prohibited during the school day or at school functions or activities. Any student violating the dress code the first time will be allowed to correct the violation. If a student cannot correct the violation at school he or she will be sent home to change or removed from the school activity immediately. Any future violations may result in suspension. All decisions regarding the appropriateness and inappropriateness of student clothing made by JAHS administrators are final!

- revealing or suggestive clothing
- clothing and jewelry with messages about alcohol, tobacco, cults, racism or profanity
- clothing and jewelry affiliated with gang membership
- hats, bandanas, hairnets, and "dew rags"
- pajamas, boxer shorts, biker shorts, hip huggers or low waist pants, micro mini skirts, short shorts, (shorts and skirts must be one inch below fingertips)
- holes in pants must be one inch below fingertips and no larger than three fingers wide
- bare midriffs, tube tops, muscle shirts, spaghetti straps
- sunglasses
- slippers (shoes, sneakers or sandals must be worn at all times and appropriately fastened)
- saggy pants or clothing that reveals/displays undergarments
- hairstyles or hair coloring that disrupt the education of others
- No visible shoulders

It is expected that John Adams students will dress for success while attending school and school activities.

PARKING

Parking Passes can be purchased from Mr. Cass for \$30.00. All students must have a parking pass to park in the school lot and the parking spaces on the street adjacent to the school. Each student who purchases a parking pass will be issued a space and assigned a number.

*Only Juniors and Seniors will be allowed to purchase a parking pass and park in the school parking spots. Underclassman wishing to drive to school will not be able to park in any school spots. Cars parked without a pass or in the incorrect spot are subject to towing.

PICTURE INFORMATION

Students will have school and ID pictures taken on Tuesday, August 20th (9th and 10th grade) and Wednesday, August 21st (11th and 12th grade) during English classes. Picture packets will be distributed prior to the August 20th with instructions to bring them home to their parents and/or guardians. If interested in purchasing school pictures, please select a package, enclose your method of payment and return it with your student to school on the 20th or 21st. Seniors will need to have at least a headshot photo taken through McDonalds Studios, as soon as possible, for the yearbook. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call school.
